



Crown's 2009 Poker Player of the Year Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Crown's Poker Player of the Year Competition (Competition) is governed by and subject to the following Terms and Conditions set out below.
2. Information on how to enter forms part of these conditions of entry.
3. Participation in the Competition constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
4. The Competition commences at 12.00am Thursday 1 January 2009 and concludes at 12.00am Thursday 31 December 2010 (Competition Period).
5. The Competition is open to all Crown Club and Crown Poker Club Members (Member).

How It Works

6. To participate in the Competition, Members must enter an eligible Crown Poker tournament during the Competition Period.
7. An eligible tournament is any multi-table cash tournament with a minimum buy-in of \$20 in which the highest place-getters are awarded cash prizes.
8. An eligible tournament does not include free-to enter, satellites and invitation-only tournaments.
9. There is no limit to the number of eligible tournaments a Member may enter throughout the competition period
10. Members will be awarded Player of the Year Points (POY Points) when they place (receive a cash prize) in an eligible tournament.
11. Once a Member has earned one or more POY points, their total POY Points score will be displayed in a leader board on the crownpoker.com.au website and on a screen in the Crown Poker Room.
12. POY Points are calculated by multiplying points earned for the following three criteria:

Criteria 1 – Position Finished

1 st	120 points
2 nd	100 points
3 rd	80 points
4 th	60 points
5 th	50 points
6 th	40 points
7 th	30 points
8 th	20 points
9 th	10 points
10 th	6 points
11 th – 20 th	3 points
21 st – 30 th	2 points
31 st +	1 point

In events with at least a \$2,000 buy-in, 11th to 20th place = 4 points, 21st to 30th = 3 points, 31st – 40th = 2 points and 41st = 1 point.

Criteria 2 – The Buy-In

\$20-\$74	1 point
\$75-\$299	2 points
\$300-\$999	3 points
\$1,000-\$9,999	4 points
\$10,000 +	5 points

The buy-in for rebuy tournaments is calculated by dividing the total prize pool by the number of entrants.



Criteria 3 – Number of Entrants

10-20	0.6 point
21-40	0.7 point
41-60	0.8 point
61-80	0.9 point
81-100	1 point

For every 20 additional entrants (101-120, 121-140 etc.) the number of points increases by 0.1 with the number of entrants rounded to the nearest 20. For example 200 entrants = 1.5 points, 300 entrants = 2 points. The maximum points awarded for the number of entrants is 5.

Example

If a Member places third in a \$500 buy-in event that had 200 entrants they would receive 360 POY points (80 points for third place x 3 points for a \$500 buy-in x 1.5 points for 200 entrants).

13. In the case where there is a tie between two or more Members in a tournament, each will receive an average of the points available. For example, if two players tie for the ninth place, each receives half of the ninth and tenth place points.
14. Bonus points (such as Double Points Week) may be ascribed to selected tournaments at Crown's discretion at any time during the Competition Period. These will be advertised to all Mailable Crown Club members and also on the crownpoker.com.au website.

Player of the Month

15. Each month, the Member who accumulated the most points in the applicable month will be awarded Crown Player of the Month award.
16. The start and end dates of each month are as follows:
 - Commences 6.00am Thursday 1 January 2009, concludes 6.00am Sunday 1 February 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Sunday 1 February 2009, concludes 6.00am Sunday 1 March 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Sunday 1 March 2009, concludes 6.00am Wednesday 1 April 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Wednesday 1 April 2009, concludes 6.00am Friday 1 May 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Monday 1 June 2009, concludes 6.00am Wednesday 1 July 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Wednesday 1 July 2009, concludes 6.00am Saturday 1 August 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Saturday 1 August 2009, concludes 6.00am Tuesday 1 September 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Tuesday 1 September 2009, concludes 6.00am Thursday 1 October 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Thursday 1 October 2009, concludes 6.00am Sunday 1 November 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Sunday 1 November 2009, concludes 6.00am Tuesday 1 December 2009
 - Commences 6.00am Tuesday 1 December 2009, concludes 6.00am Friday 1 January 2010
17. Each Player of the Month will be awarded with \$500 in Tournament Vouchers.
18. The Top 10 players each month will also be invited back for a Player of the Month Freeroll with \$1,000 in Tournament Freeplay Vouchers to be won.
19. The total value of all Player of the Month prizes is AUD \$18,000.



End of Year Prizes

20. At the end of the Program Period, the ten (10) Members with the highest number of POY Points will receive a prize as follows:

The value of the End of Year prizes is \$41,250.

Top 50 Freeroll

21. The 50 Members with the most POY Points at the end of the Program Period will qualify for a freeroll tournament whereby the winner receives entry into the 2010 Aussie Millions Main Event worth \$10,500.
22. Total value of Top 50 Freeroll prize: \$10,500.
23. The total value of all prizes for the Program is \$56,250.



Important notice to all patrons

24. Copies of these Program Terms and Conditions will be available for viewing at the Poker Desk.
25. Crown reserves the right and license to use selected Members' names, suburbs, photographs, images and likenesses for the purpose of promoting and advertising Crown and the Crown Entertainment Complex.
26. The Program is only open to Members aged 18 years and over.
27. Employees of Crown and the Burswood Group of companies are not permitted to enter the Program.
28. The Program is not open to Members excluded from the Casino pursuant to the provisions of the Casino Control Act or who are otherwise excluded.
29. This clause does not apply to the extent that Crown's liability (if any) arises from an act of Crown in respect of its supply of services and/or goods to a patron in the ordinary course of Crown's business.

31. Crown shall not be liable in any way if Points fail to accumulate or are unavailable as a result of technical malfunction or operator fault.
32. Crown's decision in connection with any aspect of the Program will be binding and final on each participant.
33. Any failure to comply with these Terms and Conditions may result in immediate disqualification of the selected winner. Disqualification will be at Crown's sole discretion and no correspondence will be entered into.
34. Members who win a Player of the Month award will be notified via telephone and in writing.
35. Members who win the End of Year Prize will be notified via telephone and in writing.
36. In the case where two or more Members tie for Player of the Month, the Members involved will equally share the Player of the Month prize.
37. In the case where two or more Members tie for first place for the End of Year Prize, the Members involved will be invited to play each other in a No Limit Holdem tournament at a date and time determined by Crown. The winner of the tournament will be awarded the first place prize while the runner-up will receive the second place prize and so on.
38. In the case where there is a tie between two or more Members for second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth or tenth place, each player will receive an equal share of the total value of the prizes.
39. The prizes are not negotiable or transferable.
40. Crown practises the responsible service of gaming.
